Students take a combination of courses in music, visual arts, and cinema, as well as analytical courses in creative development, art criticism, history, and theory. Students are guided to discover their artistic strengths through hands-on experience. They will complete several independent projects, culminating with the creation of a large-scale integrative project. Graduating students present this project to a jury of teachers for their final Comprehensive Assessment.
